## **Assessments**

All NEW students will complete an assessment BEFORE the school year starts to assist the teachers in planning and to appropriately assist/guide students in their learning journey.

Prior to the start of the school year teachers will review IEPs/504B plans submitted for students. Students are tested prior to Winter Break (if needed) and in the Spring (State Required)

Teacher conferences are held at least twice per. Any additional meetings are scheduled as needed.

We are Christian school. Students will pray, learn scriptures and truths from the Bible, be taught via Christian curriculum and expect to adhere to the school's culture and standards.
